

Most members are professionals in areas spanning from banking, accounting, to public servant, public relations. Others own and operate their own businesses in Australia and/or overseas, whilst others are homemakers supporting their families.

Members of Way In Network regularly take part in hands on community services. Most notably, during times of disaster and misfortune, the Way In Network respond without delay in setting up the fund raising activities to strive to assist
