

Message from Australian Gynaecological Cancer Foundation of Royal Hospital for Women Professor Neville Hacker AM

On behalf of our Chair, Leonie Young, Ambassador, Jean Kittson, and the members of the Board of the Australian Gynaecological Cancer Foundation (AGCF), I would like to thank the Way In Network for choosing to support our charity this year.

I would also like to congratulate them for the wonderful work they have done over the past 22 years in serving immigrant women in NSW, helping them settle and engaging them in worthwhile charitable activities.

The AGCF is a new Foundation, dedicated to raising money for research into gynaecological cancers. There has never been a Foundation in Australia dedicated to raising research dollars for all gynaecological cancers, in spite of the fact that as a group, they account for about 5,000 new cases and about 1700 deaths each year. This means that a woman dies of a gynaecological cancer every 5 hours in Australia.

This is a crucial time for research into all types of cancer. We now know that cancer is caused by changes in genes, called mutations. The completion of the Human Genome Project about 10 years ago has seen an unprecedented explosion in cancer research, and new "gene therapies" are being developed in rapid succession.

Advances in the diagnosis and treatment of any type of cancer are directly proportional to the amount of research money spent on that cancer, and through this newly established AGCF, we hope to be able to direct much more research money toward the gynaecological cancers in the future.

Congratulation again on the important work that you are doing, and thank you for supporting the AGCF this year.



ABOUT WAY IN NETWORK

Way in Network Inc. is a migrant women association which was incorporated in 1992 with an aim to support and assist women migrating to New South Wales to integrate into the Australian society.

The current committee team is led by President Linda Tang JP, and well consulted by Past Presidents Mrs, Florence Chau and Cr. Annie Tang as the Honorary Advisors.

The board of Honorary Presidents including:

- The Hon. Helen Sham-Ho OAM JP, Former MLC, NSW Parliament
- Mrs. Jenny Wallis, Former Director, Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office

Our membership has grown from an initial handful of founder members to over 100.

Members are women having migrated from countries such as Hong Kong, People Republic of China, Singapore, Indonesia, Malaysia, Vietnam, Thailand and Taiwan. Most of our members hold professional positions in industries spanning from banking, finance, accounting, marketing, public relations and welfare to the public service. Others own and operate successful businesses in Australia and or overseas, whilst others are homemakers. As an ongoing process our members continue to assist women newly migrated to Sydney,

Members of Way In Network regularly take part in hands on community services. Most notably, during times of disaster and misfortune, the Way In Network respond without delay in setting up the fund raising activities to assist those affected.

In 2002, the Way in Network received a Community Service Award from the NSW Government. This award highlights the recognition of the mainstream society to the work and effort of Way In network members.

In 2009 we received the Victoria Bush Fire Appeal Appreciation from the NSW governor.

In 2010 Haiti earthquake, we received the appreciation from Haiti Honourable Ambassador for our prompt appeal; this was greatly recognised for Way In spirit had extended borderless.
