It was likely late 1992 when I first met Mrs. Lui, a member of the Way In Network. We quickly became close friends, and about two years later, she invited me to join the association. By then, I had developed a deep respect for its mission: helping new immigrants integrate into mainstream society and organizing charitable activities for those in need. Whether working directly or through organizations like the Heart Foundation, Cancer Foundation, CanRevive, and Barnardos etc, the impact was clear. I joined without hesitation.

I eventually had the honor of serving as the ninth and tenth President.

During my presidency, I was the branch manager for HSBC in Chatswood. HSBC was incredibly supportive of its employees and, by extension, the Way In Network. Their support peaked at our 10th Anniversary Charity Ball. Beyond their usual sponsorship—which included opening accounts with an initial \$1,000 deposit—they managed to make the impossible possible. Their IT department created a unique credit card featuring the repeating number “3333 3333 3333” specifically for our auction. My dear friend Mrs. Lui auctioned the card for \$30,000, contributing to a total of \$70,000 raised that night for Barnardos. That was a huge amount over 20 years ago.

Local and international media reported on this event, but for us, it wasn't about publicity. It was about showing Australia the significant contributions of Asian women. It perfectly embodied our spirit of integration and service.

On behalf of the Australian Gynaecological Cancer Foundation (AGCF), I would like to congratulate the Way In Network on their 34 years of service as one of the oldest Chinese Australian women's support organisations in New South Wales, while contributing to the broader Australian community through their tireless charity work.

The AGCF was very fortunate to be introduced to the Way in Network very early in our existence by the Honourable Marie Ficarra OAM, the former Mayor of Hurstville, and later member of both the Upper and Lower Houses of the New South Wales Parliament.

The Way In Network generously raised the money that allowed the AGCF to offer our first 2-year Research Fellowship into gynaecological cancer in 2017. The Fellowship was awarded to Dr Dane Cheasley from the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre in Melbourne, who was beginning his research on low-grade serous ovarian cancer. This is an uncommon type of ovarian cancer, but one which often affects young women and responds poorly to chemotherapy. Hence, it has a disproportionately high mortality rate once it has spread beyond the ovary.

With the aid of the Way In Network's Fellowship, Dr Cheasley and his team were able to increase their research output, attract more research funding and develop important international collaborations. Dr Cheasley is now considered to be one of the world's leading authorities on low-grade serous ovarian cancers, and he is the first to acknowledge his path to success began with the Research Fellowship he received from the Way in Network.

Over the ensuing years, the Way In Network members have become important Ambassadors for the AGCF, and we have attended many of their annual dinners. They have continued to support our efforts in raising funds for life saving research and community awareness of the 8 gynaecological cancers, and for this we are indeed grateful.

We wish President Jessie Xiao, and her enthusiastic Board members, together with Ms Daisy Lam, Event Chair, and her committee, continuing success with all their endeavours, and we look forward to the Network's ongoing partnership with the AGCF.

To address this, TOGA has launched new molecular testing guidelines and is conducting targeted clinical trials, such as OCEANIC, to improve outcomes.
